Subject: Approval of Turkish Technic Personnel - Istanbul

Air Canada hereby authorizes the Turkish Technic Personnel listed on 'Attachment A' to perform work as specified in the contract between Turkish Technic and Air Canada (Transport Canada Civil Aviation (TCCA)- Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) 32-03).

The individual(s) listed on Attachment "A" is (are) granted approval, according to the aircraft type, to sign a maintenance release on behalf of Air Canada in accordance with Air Canada's Control Manual (policies and procedures). The individual authorization is granted based on the internal Turkish Technic personnel certification system and remains valid for a period of 3 years after the completion of the Air Canada Policy Manual training provided their Turkish Technic authorization remains valid. This authority is limited to the privileges and limitations issued to the employee on behalf of Turkish Technic.

This approval is granted as an extension of Air Canada's AMO 32-03 and is limited to Aircraft Maintenance performed in Istanbul, Turkey. This approval is valid until Turkish Technic or Air Canada terminates the contract.

For tracking purposes, Turkish Technic personnel must use the assigned 'Air Canada Sign off number' when certifying (signing) all log books and other work documentation. Please provide your personnel with the attached Authorization card(s), which must be signed by the employee and may be required to be presented on demand.

Please advise our office of any changes to the list of Turkish Technic Personnel holding authorities issued by Air Canada.
